Key Highlights of 2025

THIS YEAR HAS BEEN ONE OF GROWTH, INNOVATION, AND IMPACT FOR THE ASHTON HOPE KEEGAN FOUNDATION.

Some key highlights include:

- **Hope Gala Fundraising:** Our 2025 Hope Gala, A Starry, Starry Night, raised just under \$90,000, representing a significant share of the \$199,280 we raised in 2025.
- **Foundation Impact:** In 2025, the Foundation provided direct scholarships and material support to 101 women, empowering them to move closer to their educational and career goals. For the third year in a row, we supported more than 100 women directly. Alongside the hundreds served each year through the Ashton Hope Keegan Learning Lab, this collective impact reaches over 800 women in just three years.
- **Access to Education:** The Ashton Hope Keegan Learning Lab continued to provide GED programs in 2025, providing women with a supportive environment to build foundational skills and take critical steps toward long-term stability and opportunity.
- **Business Community Leadership:** The business community once again rose to the challenge in 2025, providing essential financial support, sponsorships, and in-kind contributions that help power the Foundation's mission and expand its impact.
- **Collaborative Community Partnerships:** Through continued partnerships and referrals with local nonprofits, including Divas Who Win, Lydia's Place, The Salvation Army, and Acceptance Recovery Center, we ensured that women received comprehensive support to address the full range of barriers on their path to success.

These achievements would not have been possible without our incredible community of donors, sponsors, volunteers, and partners. Your generosity and belief in our mission fuel every milestone we reach. We are deeply grateful for your continued support, and we look forward to building on these successes together in the years ahead.



The mission of the Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation is to break the cycle of generational poverty for women in the Athens, Georgia area and surrounding counties by providing skills-based training scholarships, grants for material support, and aligning with strategic partners. Our vision is a community where all women and their children can prosper.

How 2025 Aligned with Our Mission

In 2025, the Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation made tremendous progress in advancing its mission to empower women through education and support services:

- **Empowering Through Scholarships:** We awarded scholarships to 101 women this year, ensuring access to skills-based training programs that prepare them for middle-class careers in nursing, phlebotomy, and early childhood education. 2025 marks our third consecutive year of directly assisting over 100 women.
- **Breaking Barriers to Success:** By funding secondary and tertiary expenses, such as application fees, licensing costs, and bulk purchases of professional gear, we removed financial roadblocks that often prevent women from transitioning from their educational successes directly into their first professional role.
- **Expanding Reach:** Almost one-quarter of 2025 fundraising support came from beyond Athens, expanding our reach, strengthening sustainability, and introducing new investment into the community.
- **Strategic Collaboration:** Local businesses continue to play a vital role in advancing the Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation's mission. When called upon, the business community consistently rises to the challenge, offering financial support, sponsorships, and in-kind contributions that strengthen programs, expand opportunity, and help ensure long-term sustainability for the women and families we serve.
- **Continued Partnerships:** Ongoing collaboration and referrals with local nonprofits, including Divas Who Win, Lydia's Place, and Acceptance Recovery Center, help ensure that women receive comprehensive support that addresses all barriers to success.

Together, these efforts reflect a year defined by purpose and progress. In 2025, the Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation remained focused on meeting women where they are, investing in meaningful support, and building partnerships that extend impact beyond any single program or moment. By aligning resources, collaboration, and community leadership, we continued to advance a mission rooted in opportunity, dignity, and lasting change for women and their families.



2025 Accomplishments

SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED:

Scholarships Awarded: In 2025, we supported 101 women with scholarships and material support. Since our inception, we have directly empowered 546 women to pursue education and career opportunities.

TOTAL FUNDING DISTRIBUTED:

This year, we provided \$142,195 in direct financial support to women in need.

EVENTS ORGANIZED:

- **2025 Hope Gala:** Held under the theme A Starry, Starry Night, the Gala raised \$87,410.
- **2025 Stiletto Stampede 5k:** Our third annual Stiletto Stampede was primarily intended to raise awareness for Ashton's Foundation, but ended up raising more than \$3,500 as a bonus!
- **33 for 33 Campaign:** Launched in December 2025, the 33 for 33 Campaign gained early momentum, raising nearly \$1,200 in the first weeks.

PARTNERSHIPS ESTABLISHED:

We expanded our collaboration with four new educational institutions, increasing our total to seven. These partnerships allow us to connect more women with the resources and training programs they need to succeed.

33 FOR 33: EARLY MOMENTUM, LASTING IMPACT:

In December 2025, the Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation launched the 33 for 33 Campaign, a year-long initiative rooted in meaning and hope. Ashton's life was cut short at just 23, and 2026 would have marked her 33rd birthday. Rather than focusing on the years lost, the Foundation chose to celebrate what Ashton continues to accomplish through the lives she has changed in her name.

The campaign honors Ashton's legacy by inviting supporters to be part of something enduring. Even in its earliest days, 33 for 33 gained strong momentum, raising nearly \$1,200 during its December kickoff as donors from near and far stepped forward to celebrate her birthday and invest in the future of women and families pursuing stability and opportunity.

As the campaign continues, 33 for 33 represents more than a fundraising effort. It is a celebration of impact, community, and the belief that hope grows when people come together. This early momentum marks the beginning of a powerful year ahead, fueled by purpose and the enduring legacy of a life that continues to inspire. Featured Story

A MOTHER'S STRENGTH AND A NEW BEGINNING

At 22, Amauri is already the proud mother of two young boys. Living in a confidential shelter supported by Project Safe, Amauri is working toward stability, independence, and a future built on purpose for herself and her children.

Motherhood has been the defining force in Amauri's life. She became a mom at 19 while pursuing her lifelong dream of becoming a nurse. Balancing college coursework with childcare and limited support eventually led her to make the difficult decision to pause her education. "Being a mom comes first," she says. "Every choice I've made since then has been guided by that responsibility."

Amauri's journey has not been easy. She has faced job loss, housing insecurity, and moments of deep uncertainty. Yet her determination never wavered. With reliable childcare and a flexible job finally in place, she knew it was time to return to school and invest in her future. "Now that I've got my motivation back," she says, "nothing can stop me."

Education has always carried deep meaning for Amauri. Graduating high school was a milestone she achieved despite personal loss, family challenges, and limited resources. Encouraged by mentors and teachers who believed in her, she finished strong. "I graduated for myself," she says, "but I walked that stage for my cousin, whose life was taken too soon."

With financial support from the Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation, Amauri reached a significant milestone in October 2025. She graduated from Innovative Health Care Institute, passed her exam to become a Certified Nursing Assistant, and received a job offer from Pruitt Health. Today, she is one step closer to her ultimate dream of becoming a traveling pediatrician, bringing compassionate care to children around the world.

Statistics & Impact

**TOTAL FUNDS
RAISED IN 2025**

In 2025, the Foundation raised \$200,000, a slight decrease from 2024, reflecting broader economic uncertainty nationwide. Despite this temporary dip, our three-year moving average continues to trend upward, and we remain optimistic that improving economic conditions will support renewed growth.

BREAKDOWN OF DONOR SOURCES

- **Individual Contributions:** 6% of total funds, with virtually all of the donations being \$250 or less. This highlights the broad support from members of our community.
- **Corporate Sponsors:** 5%, including a recurring naming sponsor for the Hope Gala that contributed \$30,000.
- **Fundraising Events:** 71%, driven by the Hope Gala and Stiletto Stampede 5K, as well as a few other small fundraising activities.
- **Grants and Foundations:** 18%, reflecting the largest fall-off in revenue percentage as the economic uncertainty slowed philanthropy.
- **Miscellaneous Revenue:** <1%, including interest, dividends, etc.

- Third consecutive year of support for over 100 women.

- Posts showcasing our outstanding scholarship recipients and Hope Gala success generated over 100,763 impressions (up 38.71%).
- Engagement rates on Facebook, LinkedIn, and Instagram increased by nearly 50%.

VOLUNTEERS

- **8 Board Members:** All volunteers, contributing countless hours alongside their full-time jobs. Two of our Board Members are Fellows as we partner with UGA's MBA class.
- **54 Volunteers:** Actively involved in executing our Foundation events.
- **Total Volunteer Hours:** Volunteers contributed 900+ hours to the Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation, primarily through the Hope Gala and the Stiletto Stampede 5K. This impact was made possible by a diverse and dedicated group, including honor students, Athens Technical College Interior Design students, ARAMARK community volunteers, University of Georgia MBA students, Rotarians, and individuals united by a shared commitment to improving the community.

Financial Summary

HIGH-LEVEL BREAKDOWN OF REVENUES AND EXPENSES

REVENUE STREAMS:

- **Individual Donations: ~\$12,000 (~6%)**
Individual contributions were made by ~45 people, demonstrating the generosity and commitment of members of our community. Note that these donations came from 13 states, and one donation came from Bavaria, Germany!
- **Corporate Sponsorships: ~\$10,000 (~5%)**
Includes donations from companies ranging from Fortune 50 companies to local area businesses.
- **Grant Revenue: ~\$35,000 (~18%)**
Includes 6 grants ranging from large Foundations to local Family Foundations.
- **Event Revenue: ~\$141,000 (~71%)**
Proceeds from our two signature events, the 2025 Hope Gala and the 2025 Stiletto Stampede 5K, played a vital role in funding our programs.

EXPENSE CATEGORIES:

- **Program Expenditures: \$141,195**
Direct financial support for scholarships, material assistance, bulk purchases, and operational costs for the Ashton Hope Keegan Learning Lab.
- **Operational Expenses: \$20,009**
Indirect program costs, such as Chamber of Commerce dues, web services, software licenses, etc.
- **Non-Program Expenses: \$4,900**
Administrative costs, such as office supplies and our annual audit.

TOTAL EXPENSES

The Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation is proud to maintain an exceptional level of financial accountability. In 2024, 98.7% of our funds directly supported our mission, with only 1.3% allocated to general and administrative expenses. We will submit our 2025 materials to the auditors at the end of January, and expect to get our final 2025 G&A rate sometime this summer.

As an all-volunteer organization with no brick-and-mortar facilities, we maximize the impact of every dollar raised, ensuring that the women we serve receive the support they need to break the cycle of generational poverty. Our financials are reviewed annually through a rigorous audit process to ensure transparency and adherence to best practices in non-profit management, and those audits are posted on our website to ensure that transparency.

Programs in Focus

KEY PROGRAMS FUNDED BY SCHOLARSHIPS

The Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation provides scholarships to empower women through skills-based training programs. We funded tuition, books, supplies, and material assistance for women enrolled in 41 program areas, such as:

These scholarships ensure that women can access the education and training needed to secure stable, well-paying careers, lifting themselves and their families out of poverty. Additionally, we addressed critical secondary and tertiary expenses, such as application fees, background checks, and certification costs, eliminating financial barriers that often prevent women from completing their education.

Programs in Focus

WORKSHOPS AND TRAINING PROGRAMS SUPPORTED

In collaboration with educational institutions and community partners, the foundation supported the following training programs in 2025:



Ashton Hope Keegan Learning Lab:

Equipped with 17 networked computers, this lab provides a technology-driven environment for GED education and career preparation. Women gain critical computer skills, build resumes, and access job-search tools, significantly improving their educational outcomes. The lab also enhances the English as a Second Language program, and programs that bring English-speaking women up to a level of proficiency that ensures they can complete their GEDs.



Professional Development Workshops:

Hosted in partnership with local organizations, these workshops cover topics such as interview preparation, resume writing, and workplace communication, equipping women with the tools they need to succeed in their chosen careers.



Angel Tree Program:

Addressing the unique challenges faced by impoverished women during the holiday season, this program supported students by ensuring their children received holiday gifts. This initiative reduced dropout rates during a critical period and reinforced our mission to lift women and their children out of generational poverty.

In 2025, we were able to help provide gifts for 133 children. We supported 49 moms with gift cards for food, Amazon, or Walmart.



Programs in Focus

OUTCOMES

The impact of our programs is reflected in the meaningful progress made by the women we serve.

Certificates and Training Progress

Women supported by the Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation continue to earn certifications in high-demand fields such as healthcare, education, and skilled trades. Others remain actively enrolled in training programs that span multiple semesters and are progressing toward completion.

Employment and Opportunity

Many participants receive job offers during or shortly after completing their training, often securing positions that provide greater stability, growth potential, and a path toward long-term economic independence.

Career Advancement

Women supported through our programs are advancing toward life-changing professional milestones, building confidence, credentials, and momentum that extend well beyond their initial training.

How Do We Know We're Succeeding?

Excluding the COVID years when schools were closed, only two students have ever been at risk of not completing their programs. In one case, a student was disenrolled by the school due to challenges adapting to the learning environment, and scholarship funds were promptly redirected to support another woman. In the other, a non-academic barrier threatened enrollment. By connecting the student with a partner nonprofit, the issue was resolved and she successfully completed her training.

Together, these outcomes demonstrate the transformative power of education and the importance of individualized support in helping women overcome barriers and build sustainable futures.

Goals for 2026

EMPOWERING WOMEN, TRANSFORMING LIVES

At the Ashton Hope Keegan Foundation, our mission is to break the cycle of generational poverty for women in Northeast Georgia by empowering them through education, removing barriers to success, and supporting their transition into the professional workforce. Our goals for 2026 reflect a bold vision for growth and impact, and we invite you to join us in making these goals a reality.

GOAL #1: Expanding Access to GED Education

We aim to increase GED completion by 25%, supporting at least 34 women through up to \$10,000 in scholarships and testing assistance. Strategic partnerships with Women to the World, Athens Technical College, and United Way of Northeast Georgia will help remove barriers and ensure access to this critical milestone.

GOAL #2: Supporting Skills-Based Training

We aim to increase enrollment in technical and certification programs by 25%, awarding \$1,000 scholarships to at least 162 women. Partnerships with Innovative Healthcare Institute, Athens Technical College, and continued engagement with GED graduates will support smooth transitions into skills-based programs that lead to sustainable careers.

GOAL #3: Investing in High School Graduates

We will award \$1,000 scholarships to at least 10 students transitioning directly from high school into technical training who do not qualify for the HOPE scholarship. In partnership with the Rotary Club of Athens and local high schools, we will help remove financial barriers and expand access to career-focused education.

GOAL #4: Removing Workforce Barriers

We will invest at least \$10,000 to remove final financial barriers to employment by providing professional gear and covering certification exam costs. Through partnerships with training schools, we will ensure graduates can transition confidently and immediately into the workforce.
